- 3. Commit at least \$5M over 5 years through the ZB Foundation to non-profit organizations doing the work of anti-racism and supporting diversity, equality and justice.
- 4. Match, through the ZB Foundation, team member financial contributions to non-profit organizations, including those dedicated to combatting racism and supporting diversity, equality and justice.
- 5. Expand our student and early career internship programs to attract and develop more Black leaders.
- 6. Continue our industry leadership and financial support of Movement is Life, a multi-disciplinary coalition seeking to eliminate racial, ethnic and gender disparities in muscle and joint health.
