



Canada Direct Fellowship Funding Program

Zimmer Biomet is committed to improving patient care in the communities in which we operate and do business. As part of this commitment, Zimmer Biomet considers requests for fellowship grant funding to support health care professionals with their education, training and experience in clinical research. Zimmer Biomet believes quality education, training and clinical research benefits the patient and advances medical technology, treatments, and knowledge.

Funding for CMF/Thoracic fellowship programs will be awarded in the range of \$15,000 – \$50,000 CAD based on the demonstrated need of the program. Funding for all other orthopaedic subspecialty fellowship programs will be awarded in the amount of \$50,000 CAD or the demonstrated need of the program, whichever is lower. All grant funding decisions are at the discretion of the Zimmer Biomet Fellowship Review Committee. Due to the substantial amount of each grant award, the number of grants will be limited. Therefore, it is possible that not all applicants will receive funding. A decision to provide fellowship grant funding is never contingent upon, or related to, the purchase, lease, recommendation, procurement, use, or prescription of Zimmer Biomet products and services.
