

New Medicare Policy Allows Payment to ASCs for Total Knee Arthroplasty

TKA Added to ASC Covered Procedures List, Effective January 1, 2020

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has announced a significant change to its ambulatory surgery center (ASC) policy on total knee arthroplasty (TKA) for discharges occurring on or after January 1, 2020. A claim reflecting CPT coding for TKA (27447) will result in a national unadjusted payment to the facility of \$8,610, in addition to professional fees separately billed.

CMS is adding total knee arthroplasty to the ASC Covered Procedures List, effective January 1, 2020. This means TKA procedures, such as ones using the Persona® The Personalized Knee, the Vanguard® Knee System or the NexGen® Complete Knee Solution, may be covered in the ASC setting starting with dates of service on the effective date. While the 2020 policy change specifically applies to TKA, partial knee arthroplasty (PKA) has been on the ASC Covered Procedures List since 2008.

Effective January 1, 2020, Medicare will allow payment to ASCs performing TKA procedures:

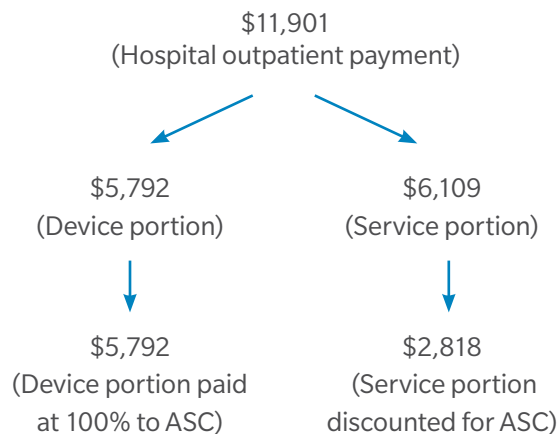

When comparing the payment amounts between the different sites of service, it is important to know that CMS has deemed TKA to be a “device intensive procedure.” This specific ASC reimbursement methodology helps ensure that the payment to the ASC is adequate for the implantable device used in the procedure.

- The ASC is paid the same amount for the device-related portion of the procedure that would be reimbursed for the device under OPPTS.
 - The hospital outpatient facility and the ASC receive equal payment for the device.
- The remaining service portion of the procedure’s hospital outpatient payment is reduced according to the standard ASC payment rate methodology.
 - This reduction is to account for the expected lower overhead of an ASC compared to a hospital outpatient department.

Device Intensive Payment Example:



Total ASC Payment for TKA:
\$5,792 + \$2,818 = \$8,610

The labor portion of an ASC’s payment is adjusted by the applicable local wage index to account for geographic differences in wages and other input costs. The tables below provide the calendar year 2020 Medicare ASC payment rates, sorted by state then CBSA, for TKA (CPT code 27447). The reported amounts reflect the fee-for-service sequestration payment reduction in effect since April 1, 2013.
